Promoting breastfeeding at work is not only beneficial for the well-being of mothers and their babies, but it is also helpful for your business and company. When companies encourage employees by having policies and designated space for pumping, employees feel supported and have higher job satisfaction. As you know, productive, satisfied, and experienced employees mean less employee turnover and lower costs in recruiting and training. There are a lot of studies about how supporting breastfeeding moms also leads to lower health care costs, lower absenteeism rates, and higher retention rates.
